

## **US Social Justice Worker Asserts that Revolution is Alive and Well in Her Country**

Caracas, Nov 10 – Tufara LaShelle Waller, a social justice worker with the US Highlander community center, assured those gathered that there is currently a nascent revolution in the United States being led by social justice movements.

In her energetic speech, which started with a song, she highlighted the importance of racial and environmental justice, as well as democratic participation, as key aspects in current struggles.

“Young people are open and aware and are revolutionizing the country from the inside,” said the American who works to combat economic injustice, prejudice, and the destruction of the environment.

From the Generalísimo Francisco de Miranda Park, at the International Book Fair, she highlighted her work at the Highlander Center, where she utilizes art and culture as organizing strategies.

Tufara LaShelle Waller, a special guest to the *United States: A Possible Revolution* forum, stated that Highlander was founded in 1932 as an adult education center and serves the grassroots workers of social justice movements.

Also, this center has been host to civil rights activists such as Rosa Parks, Martin Luther King Jr, and Stokely Carmichael, among others.
